**ILEARN 2021-** ILEARN is Indiana’s online computer adaptive assessment designed to measure your child’s proficiency of the Indiana Academic Standards in Grades 3–8, Biology and U.S. Government. ILEARN fulfills both state and federal legislative requirements as the accountability assessment for Indiana students.

**What resources are available to help prepare my child for ILEARN?**

The State of Indiana has designated Monday, April 19 through Friday, May 14 as the ILEARN testing window. St. Charles plans to begin the tests on Monday, April 19, for students in grades 3 through 8. If students are not absent, testing should be completed by Tuesday, April 27. Make-up tests will be given to students who have been absent, but these are not in the best testing environment, as testing space and test administrators are not as readily available. Please help the students to be in school and on time. All testing will be online this year. **Gr. 3-8 students will be using their Chromebooks. All grade 3-8 students will need headphones/earbuds for testing. Please ask your child if s/he has theirs or if it needs to be replaced. Thank you!**

All students must take these tests in person at school. There is no remote testing. We will work to schedule those students that might be quarantined or that are remote at the time to get their tests completed during the test window.

## 21st Century Scholars Program

Your children may be eligible for college tuition through the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Scholars program. Students in the 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grade who qualify for the program can receive up to four years of college tuition to attend an eligible Indiana public or private college or university. The scholarship may be reduced depending on the availability of the student's family to contribute to college. Income guidelines:

<u>Household Size</u>	<u>Maximum Annual Income</u>
2	\$31,894
3	\$40,182
4	\$48,470
5	\$56,758
6	\$65,046

For each additional person in the household, add \$8,288

\* The scholarship amount may be reduced depending on the availability of funds and the availability of the student's family to contribute to college.

**The only time you can apply for this program is when the student is in 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grade.
